2. Rev 2:20 Sometimes at the workplace the world demands us to compromise our integrity.

- What are ways we could be put into a compromising situation? What are some ways that we could handle this?

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The church of Pergamos allowed the spirit of Balaam and Nicolaitans to influence the church.

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As in the case of the reference to Balaam, in the letter to the Church of Pergamos, we can assume, the name is used symbolically, and yet may refer to a real person and a specific situation within the Thyatira church.

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The Scriptures teach that God is a God of mercy who does not want the death of anyone. He wants the people to repent and live. But when sinners refuse his pleas and warnings, they choose death. The woman called Jezebel was one of them.

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Although the city itself may have been regarded as unimportant, the church there was certainly not, and neither were its problems!

The situation at Thyatira has to do with a person or perhaps a movement which or who is described by the name of "*Jezebel*."

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
